March 2005: 8 computers/600 students

May: 4 Oneworld provides St. Kizito 6 computers.
14 computers/600 students

July : 4 Oneworld provides 5 computers and 1 printer.
19 computers/600 students

November: Student body is now 700 and 2 computers stop working.

January 2006: 4 Oneworld launches the St. Kizito Computer Literacy Project The plan will fund

- a computer teacher
- the computer lab
- Internet

For 5 years. That's right, 5 years! 2006-2011

April: Fundraiser raised \$20,000!

May: 4 Oneworld begins funding the computer teacher, Denis Mwai.

August: 4 Oneworld places order with U-Connect (make it so they can click & be directed to www.u-connect.org)

September: Live Music Fundraiser raised \$6200!

October: Computers are received.
